- What lessons can you draw from the role-play about interacting and engaging the community?

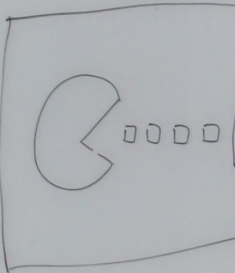
